President's Report

Micheal updated the membership on the vegetation problems on the lake. Lake Fork is experiencing some hydrilla issues that can be beneficial to the fishery, and alligator weed, which can cause some access problems. But the "biggest threat" to Lake Fork, he said, is water hyacinth. It was first spotted in a creek leading into the lake in 1993 and was attacked aggressively.

When a moratorium was placed on spraying in 1998 it allowed the vegetation to gain ground, he said, and the rapid expansion has the SRA and TPWD's attention.

Annual treatments of herbicides are currently being used to control the water hyacinth. However, TPWD does not have the manpower or funds to address the current spread of water hyacinth on the lake. Micheal suggested, and the membership has agreed, to take a proactive stance against this threat to our Lake. By a vote of the members present at the November meeting it was agreed that the LFSA would lead a fund raising drive to assist in the purchase of chemicals and/or a spraying operation around the entire lake. The membership has authorized the Board of Directors to move forward with developing a plan for this fundraiser.

Know Your Board of Director Candidates

It is time to elect four (4) LFSA Directors to replace those whose terms expire this year. The 4 positions open for election are: 2 Guides, 1 Merchant and 1 Homeowner.

Three of the new Directors will be elected for a two year term. To help improve the balance in future elections, the Board has agreed that the elected Guide Director receiving the lowest number of votes will serve only one year.

The requirements for being a Director are:

- The candidate must be a full member in good standing for 2010.
- The candidate must attend most monthly Association meetings and routinely scheduled Board meetings.
- The candidate must participate in Association committees and/or projects.
